

COVID 19 – CORONAVIRUS {House Rules Attachment}

Covid 19 Symptoms - if any of your group is unwell or displays *symptoms before arrival the group should not use the hall and follow government guidelines on testing/isolation.

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- **High temperature** – this means you feel hot to touch on your chest or back (you do not need to measure your temperature)
- **New, continuous cough** – this means coughing a lot for more than an hour, or 3 or more coughing episodes in 24 hours (if you usually have a cough, it may be worse than usual)
- **Loss or change to your sense of smell or taste** – this means you've noticed you cannot smell or taste anything, or things smell or taste different to normal

Covid Signage - although rules are relaxed this is there to remind everyone we need to be aware of the transmission of ALL germs.

QR Code - attendance at venue can be registered by Government app.

Hand Sanitizer - stations in foyer, hall, toilets.

Hand Washing - basins in kitchen and toilets.

Face Covering - those using hall may still wish to use face covering whilst in close contact. Face covering should be provided by host/hirer or individual attendees.

Ventilation - when possible to have doors and windows open.

Main Hall - 40 people maximum (half capacity). This will allow for a certain amount of distancing measures but it is up to each group to determine how many they want at their meeting/event up to the maximum amount.

Cleaning - very important that all groups using the hall are responsible for cleaning surfaces and equipment.

Kitchen - keep food preparation to a minimum.
